Re: 2019 Fertilizer and Herbicide Applications - Charter Township of Oakland, Parks and

The bid documents for the 2019 Fertilizer and Herbicide Application Services - Charter Township of Oakland, Parks and Recreation shall be supplemented, amended, or otherwise revised as itemized below.

Please insert this addendum number and date in the space provided on the Bid Form of the “Request for Price” document.

1. Replace bid form cost chart with attached cost chart.
2. Add the following paragraphs to General Requirements page 7:
 - A. **Frequency of fertilizer applications:** Provide fertilizer applications on a one time basis in accordance with product and application schedule on the bid form cost chart.
 - B. **Frequency of herbicide applications:** Provide herbicide applications on an as needed spot application basis (approximately 2 times per season) paying particular attention to the perimeter of the fields. Wild flower seeds can spread along the perimeter of the fields. Herbicide applications must be timed just prior to when the dandelions are in full bloom in the spring. The Park’s Maintenance Foreman must give approval in writing before any herbicides are applied.
 - C. **Schedule:** A schedule of the proposed days and times for fertilizer and herbicide applications must be coordinated with the Park’s Maintenance Foreman and selected contractor and approved by the Park’s Director before any of the selected contractor’s field maintenance work commences. The Park’s Maintenance Foreman must be present at the time of any fertilizer or herbicide applications.
 - D. **Product and bags:** The Park’s Maintenance Foreman is required to inspect any fertilizers or herbicides to approve the product, analysis, and quantity of materials to be used before application as well as turf equipment that is being used to make sure it is properly calibrated and in good working order. Used product bags will be required to be left after application at a determined location for a representative of Oakland Township to review.

- E. **Herbicide containers:** Upon being asked by a representative of Oakland Township, selected contractor must provide container with label attached as well as the rate which herbicide was applied.
