## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR 2014 PRAIRIE RESTORATION SEED AND PLANTING

The Charter Township of Oakland Parks and Recreation Commission will receive <u>sealed</u> bids until 3:00p.m., local time, Tuesday, September 30, 2014, for **2014 Prairie Restoration Seed and Planting**. Mail or deliver bids to the Township Clerk's Office at The Charter Township of Oakland, 4393 Collins Road, Rochester, Michigan, 48306 in an envelope marked on the outside "Bids for Charter Township of Oakland Parks and Recreation – 2014 Prairie Restoration Seed and Planting". Bid documents will be available at no cost at Township offices on Thursday, September 11, 2014 or after.

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Oakland Township Parks & Recreation Commission is currently accepting bids for the **2014 Prairie Restoration Seed and Planting** for the following properties: Charles Ilsley Park (18 acres) and Draper Twin Lake Park (20 acres). Locations and an overview of the restoration sites can be found on the attached maps. Charter Township of Oakland Parks and Recreation will perform all site preparation and maintenance following planting. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to provide and/or install seed. Bidders may provide a quote for both providing and installing local ecotype seed, or an itemized bid for either providing seed or installing it.

The right is reserved by the Charter Township of Oakland Parks and Recreation Commission to accept any proposal, to reject any proposal, and to waive irregularities in proposals.

The Charter Township of Oakland will not engage in unlawful discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, height, weight, marital status, or unrelated disability.

## **INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS**

## FORM AND RECEIPT OF PROPOSALS

All proposals must be made and signed by the bidder on the bid form attached hereto. Sealed bid proposals will be received as indicated in the Advertisement for Bids.

The Oakland Township Parks & Recreation Commission is seeking to seed native prairie vegetation in old agricultural fields at Charles IIsley Park (18 acres) and Draper Twin Lake Park (20 acres). Locations and an overview of the restoration sites can be found on the attached maps. Charter Township of Oakland Parks and Recreation will perform all site preparation and maintenance following planting. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to provide and/or install seed. Bidders may provide a quote for both providing and installing local ecotype seed, or an itemized bid for either providing seed or installing it.

### SUMMARY OF WORK

#### PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The Charter Township of Oakland Parks and Recreation Commission (PRC) is seeking an itemized quote to provide and install local ecotype prairie seed in old agricultural fields at Charles Ilsley Park (18 acres) and Draper Twin Lake Park (20 acres). Locations of the parks and restoration sites can be found on the attached maps.

#### Task 1. Provide Prairie/Oak Barrens Native Prairie Seed:

- Provide local ecotype native prairie/oak barrens plant seed. We define local ecotype as sources from within 100 miles north or south of Rochester, MI and within 200 miles east or west. Include only species native to Michigan, according to the University of Michigan Herbarium (michiganflora.net)
- Moderate diversity seed mix (>30 species)
- 50:50 graminoid (grasses and sedges) to forb ratio by weight in the seed mix
- 10 lb/acre if providing Pure Live Seed (PLS), 15 lb/acre if hand-collected seed
- Favor shorter graminoid species (e.g. little bluestem and June grass) over taller graminoid species, although taller species may be included at lower rates
- Match seed mix to the soils and hydrology of the sites

### Task 2. Install Native Plant Seed:

- Planting will take place in either late Fall/early Winter 2014 or Spring 2015.
- Install by broadcasting the seed or conservation seed drill as appropriate

#### Task 3. Report:

- Prepare a report including, but not limited to, the following information (as appropriate):
   Date of planting
  - Method of planting
  - o Rate of planting, including calibration of the seed drill/broadcast equipment
  - o The amount and source (provenance) of each species included in the seed mix
  - Any deviations or special conditions encountered during seeding

### TIME OF COMPLETION

This project shall be totally completed and performed within the dates listed for each area in the Itemized Bid Specs - Work Calendar.

## PRAIRIE/OAK BARREN RESTORATION OBJECTIVE

To restore native prairie/oak barren plants to former agricultural fields to improve/increase connectivity of wildlife habitat and to educate residents about pre-settlement plant communities.

### **QUALIFICATIONS OF CONTRACTOR**

As a part of the bidding process the Contractor must submit a reference (name, address, phone number of Owner) of at least three (3) prairie restoration projects of similar size that the Contractor has been primarily responsible for and which, upon investigation, would be found to be completed in a satisfactory manner.

The Contractor shall also furnish complete evidence (a Resume or Professional Services Overview document) that they have the facilities, equipment, personnel, etc., and expertise to complete the project. Prior approval must be obtained before entering into any sub-contract for this work. The Owner reserves the right to reject any subcontractor if the evidence submitted fails to satisfy the Owner that the subcontractor is properly qualified to complete the work described.

## PROTECTION OF PARK USERS AND PROPERTY

The contractor shall secure the work area and their equipment and materials in such a manner as to ensure the safety of the public. The Contractor shall provide all barricades or personnel needed. The Contractor shall be responsible for the protection of property during the period of the contract and shall exercise care to prevent damage. The attached maps give an overview of the worksites. No work will be permitted on Weekends or Holidays.

### **COORDINATION OF WORK**

Additional contracts for work may be underway during performance of this Contract. The Contractor shall coordinate their work with all other contractors working in the area, and the Owner's personnel as required for orderly and complete fulfillment of the entire project and to keep the interference with the work of others to a minimum. The performance of the Contractor shall not jeopardize or delay the performance of other contractors or other persons working in the area.

## MAPS AND SPECIFICATIONS

The Maps and Specifications are intended to supplement each other, the two being considered cooperative, and what is required by either shall be as binding as though required by both.

Any items necessary to the completion of the work shown which may not be actually indicated on the maps or mentioned by the specifications, but which are obviously necessary and usually employed in common practice, shall be supplied in place as part of this Contract.

### SITE EVALUATION

Prior to a designing the seed mix or installing the native seed, the Contractor shall evaluate the areas. The contractor should include the soils, hydrology, aspect, and slope.

### PERMITS

The Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining all necessary permits and approvals in accordance with applicable state and local laws, codes and regulations.

#### **INSURANCE**

The Contractor shall submit a Certificate of Insurance with their bid meeting the minimum requirements of liabilities as outlined in the Appendix and have language the same as that described in the Appendix. Insurance provided by the Contractor shall also cover any subcontractors. All insurance carriers must be acceptable to the Charter Township of Oakland and licensed in the State of Michigan. The Contractor shall not allow for any lapse of insurance coverage in the amounts shown in the Appendix. Failure of the Contractor to maintain the required insurance shall be grounds for contract cancellation. The Contractor will also be required to meet these insurance requirements and indemnify Charter Township of Oakland Parks and Recreation Commission bid.

### CONCLUSION TO THE INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

It has not been our purpose in preparing these plans and specifications to make omissions and/or errors. Such omissions and/or errors, in either the plans or the specifications, shall be corrected when called to our attention. Discrepancies of any sort shall not be taken advantage of, as harmony shall be preserved at all times so that the work can be pursued efficiently and rapidly in the letter and spirit of these specifications. The true intent and meaning of the same is that all work of every kind that may be necessary for completely finishing the work, rectifying failures, and delivering a complete job be done. This is implied, although the same may not be specifically expressed.

#### **Certificate of Liability Requirements**

#### Insurance coverage and limits required are:

<u>Workers' Compensation Insurance</u>: The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract, Workers' Compensation Insurance, including Employers' Liability Coverage, in accordance with all applicable statutes of the State of Michigan. If the Contractor is a sole proprietor, in lieu of Workers' Compensation Insurance, the Contractor must submit a completed and notarized Sole Proprietor Form.

<u>Commercial General Liability Insurance</u>: The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract, Commercial General Liability Insurance on an "Occurrence Basis" with limits of liability not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and aggregate. Coverage shall include the following extensions: (A) Contractual Liability; (B) Products and Completed Operations; (C) Independent Contractors Coverage; (D) Broad Form General Liability Extensions or equivalent, if not already included ; (E) Deletion of all Explosion, Collapse, and Underground (XCU) Exclusions, if applicable.

<u>Motor Vehicle Liability</u>: The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance, including Michigan No-Fault Coverage's, with limits of liability not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit for Bodily Injury, and Property Damage. Coverage shall include all owned vehicles, all non-owned vehicles, and all hired vehicles.

<u>Additional Insured</u>: Commercial General Liability and Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance, as described above, shall include an endorsement stating the following shall be Additional Insureds: "The Charter Township of Oakland, the Charter Township of Oakland Parks and Recreation Commission, all elected and appointed officials thereof, all employees, agents and volunteers thereof, and all boards, commissions and/or authorities thereof, including all members, employees, agents and volunteers thereof."

**List Township as Certificate Holder:** Commercial General Liability and Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance shall list Charter Township of Oakland as certificate holder: Charter Township of Oakland, 4393 Collins Road, Rochester, MI 48306.

### Format for providing proof of insurance:

To provide evidence that the vendors of the Oakland Township Parks and Recreation Commission have the required types and amounts of insurance coverage during their term of service, vendors are required to provide both a Certificate of Insurance and evidence that the Charter Township of Oakland has been given Additional Insured Status on liability policies, by furnishing either the endorsement to the policy or the appropriate language from the actual policy which grants the additional insured status.
